P.U.G.S. MEMBER BIOGRAPHIES

If you'd like to be listed on our club's website, please do these two simple things:

- 1.) Email me (mccordt@purdue.edu) a photo of you (or direct me to a photo of you on Facebook). Please crop the photo so that you are the only one in the picture, if necessary. If there are other people in the picture you send me, I will crop it myself, so it would be best for you to crop it the way you want it before sending it. The photo does not necessarily need to be related to PUGS or to Geology, but it's always a plus.
- 2.) Email me (mccordt@purdue.edu) your member biography. The member biography consists of 2-3 sentences about yourself including: your name; your position in the club (if you are not an Executive or Ad Hoc member, just list yourself as a member); your major(s) (minor(s) can also be included); and any plans for the future. If you have room in the 2-3 sentences, you can add more about yourself. If the biography you send me is longer than 3 sentences, I will cut it down myself to 3 sentences as a maximum. IMPORTANT NOTE: I will start every biography with "(Insert Name Here) is..." so please write these in 3rd person. Otherwise, I'll change them to fit these guidelines, as I mentioned with the photos.

Here's an example! "George Smith is a member of PUGS, majoring in Geology and Geophysics and minoring in Mathematics. He is dedicated to participating in many service events with PUGS, such as elementary school outreach and Purdue's annual Spring Fest. After completing his undergraduate degree at Purdue University, he hopes to attend the University of Colorado for graduate studies in Geology."

These biographies are important for all members (especially Executive Members!), so I cannot stress the importance of getting these in on time! If you have paid your dues but do not send me a biography with a photo, only your name will be featured on the website's biography page (which is no fun!). Please note that there will be a new biography page for every school year, so make sure the information you put in (especially for club member positions) is relative to the year your biography is describing!
